

48.000 - SNOWMOBILE ORDINANCE Ord. No. 147 Adopted: September 15, 2005

The purpose of this ordinance is to regulate the use of snowmobiles within the Village.

THE VILLAGE OF MACKINAW CITY ORDAINS:

48.001 - Rules for the Operation of Snowmobiles within Village Limits.

Sec. 1.

- A. Snowmobiles shall be operated at a safe speed for the conditions existing at the time of the operation; provided, however, in no case shall the speed exceed 10 miles per hour unless otherwise posted.
- B. Snowmobiles shall observe and obey all Village and State traffic laws. All cross streets shall be considered stop streets for snowmobiles.
- C. Snowmobiles shall yield and give right-of-way to all vehicles and pedestrians including snowplows and shall come to a complete stop for pedestrians crossing any travel way.
- D. Not more than 2 persons shall be permitted on a snowmobile.
- E. No one shall operate a snowmobile between the hours of 12 midnight and 6:00 A.M. within the Village of Mackinaw City.
- F. All snowmobiles must operate on the right hand side of any street, road, alley, or other thoroughfare.
- G. No person shall ride any snowmobile upon any sidewalk within the limits of the Village.

48.002 - Penalty.

Sec. 2. Any violation of this Ordinance shall be a civil infraction punishable by a fine of not more than \$500.00.

48.003 - Conflicting Ordinances and Severability.

Sec. 3. All other ordinances of the Village of Mackinaw City that are in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

The sections and provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable and any portion which is declared inoperative or invalid for any reason by a court of competent jurisdiction shall in no way affect the remaining sections or provisions of this Ordinance.

48.004 - Effective Date.

Sec. 4. Ordinance No. 147, Snowmobiles shall become effective 20 days after publication in a newspaper of general circulation within the Village of Mackinaw City.
