NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Port Huron, St. Clair County, Michigan, in exercise of its home rule authority, as follows:

SECTION 2: The City of Port Huron denounces all acts of racism, intolerance and unlawful discrimination and will not tolerate them of any kind.

SECTION 3: The City of Port Huron expresses its disapproval and condemnation of any racist, intolerant and unlawful discriminatory acts.

SECTION 4: The City of Port Huron calls upon all its residents to treat each other with respect.

SECTION 5: The City of Port Huron will work with other government entities and all community partners to advance equity and inclusion to achieve a truly diverse, inclusive and tolerant environment for all residents.
