

The Michigan Municipal League's Elected Officials Academy is a voluntary continuing education program established to encourage and recognize the efforts of local elected officials to become effective leaders.

The EOA Advisory Board is comprised of 18 members, at least one of which is a manager from a full member community. The Board has powers granted by the MML Board of Trustees to administer and oversee the EOA Program.

Eligibility:

- Board members must be active participating members of the EOA (other than full member manager candidates).

Term:

- Each board member serves a term of three years and may serve a total of two consecutive terms.

Expectations & Responsibilities:

- Attend four meetings per year at the following typical dates and locations below. Board members may participate remotely as that option is available.
 - January, Virtual
 - March, Virtual
 - July, Virtual
 - September, MML Annual Convention, location varies
- Provide suggestions to League staff regarding:
 - Criteria for levels of recognition
 - Curriculum for the academy

Application Process:

- Interested candidates should send a letter of interest to Emily Kieliszewski (see contact information below). This letter will also be shared with the Board.
- The application process will strive to ensure representation from all geographic areas of the state.

Selection Process:

- Board members are appointed annually by the Board at its meeting held during the MML Annual Convention and assume office in January following their appointment.
